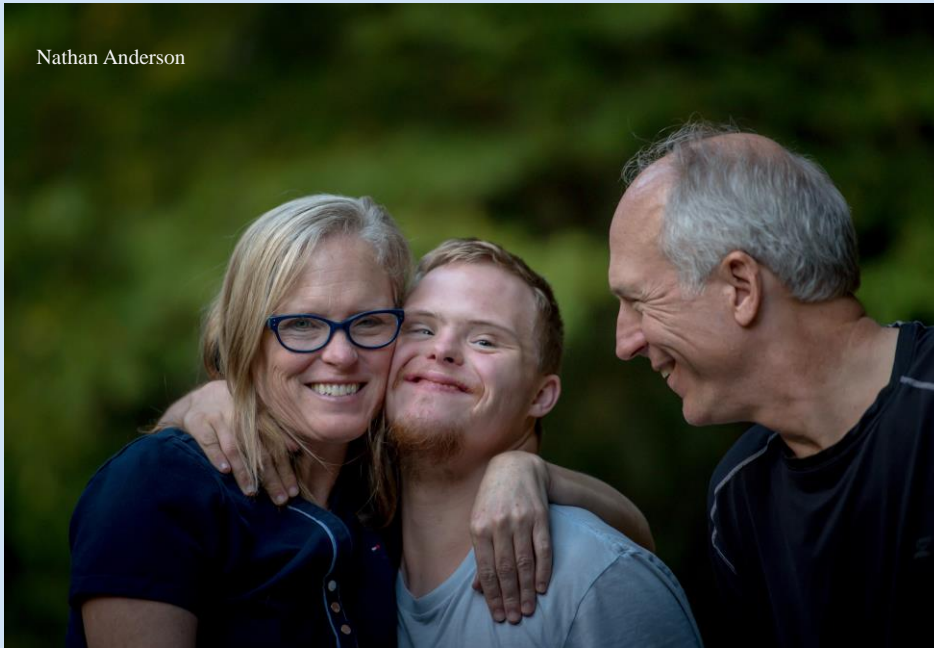


LOOKING FORWARD: A WORKSHOP ON SUCCESSION PLANNING
